OUR TEAMS

Our teams are first split by age, skill, and amount of practice time. Age divisions are determined by the International All Star Federation (IASF) and Cheer Canada (CC). Ages in our sport are calculated based on the year of the competition season. An athlete is age eligible if they are the given age for that category at any time between January 1, 2023 and December 31, 2024. The easiest way to figure it out is to look at the birth years below.

U6 (6 years and younger)	birth ages 2016-2018
U8	birth ages 2014-2018
U12	birth ages 2010-2015
U16 (previously U17)	birth ages 2006-2011
U19	birth ages 2004-2009
International Open (ages 15+)	birth ages 2008 or earlier

STREAMS

Pre-Competitive: Our pre-competitive stream is perfect for families wanting to try out our sport, have additional commitments to other activities, or are wanting to keep expenses down. The pre-competitive teams run once per week on the weekend in a non-competitive environment and offer athletes the opportunity to perform at showcases and demonstration performances while learning about our sport and working towards a routine or routine skills. There are no competition or travel expenses for our pre-competitive stream. Athletes learn all aspects of cheerleading and will learn up to a full routine.

Competitive: Our competitive stream is intended for new and/or returning athletes or athletes interested in committing to two or three practices per week in a more competitive environment. These teams require a higher level of commitment and depending on the age group, more competitions and travel expectations.

SPRING TRYOUTS

We have tryouts in the spring for Wildfire, Code Red, and Fever so that they can train over the summer preparing for the fall season.

TEAM PLACEMENTS

Athletes will have the opportunity to meet the staff, have some fun and show off their skills working with coaches on stunting, jumping, stretching, dance, and tumbling. The team placement process enables us to place kids with other kids at the same starting point so that everyone feels great with the skills and abilities they bring forward to their team and that nobody is too far ahead or too far behind their teammates. After team placements are completed for the entire club (August 25) **you will receive information in an email about which team your athlete has been placed on and the registration information pertaining to that team. You will have the team information by Sunday August 28th, 2022.** Everyone is placed on a team!

UNIFORMS

This season is the second year of a three-year uniform cycle. This three-year commitment allows families to reuse uniforms, or sell and trade the uniforms during the cycle. We will be bringing back our PRE-LOVED SALE AT THE END OF AUGUST. We strive to create a trendy, exciting uniform that athletes will love and that will look great on the competition floor. We also understand the cost of all-star cheer and try to keep uniform and gear costs reasonable, which is why we reuse our uniforms for multiple years.

Pre-competitive athletes will receive a club top (t-shirt or tank top) and will have the option to buy a skort if they choose. Otherwise they can simply wear black (or any color) shorts. Pre-competitive athletes do not need a uniform but will wear their matching tops for showcases.

Competitive team uniforms include a bodysuit and skort at minimum. The older athletes then have items added to this uniform such as sleeves and neck pieces. The skirt and bodysuit are the same club-wide with the option for differences in hair pieces and sleeves depending on the team. Every athlete will also receive a club top. The costs for the uniform are found under fees. Uniforms are sold separately, but are explained in the fee structure as they often do not need to be purchased every season.

PRACTICE SCHEDULE

The practice times may adjust a bit in the fall. We try our best to have our teams practice at age appropriate times, and have our older athletes heading home no later than 10pm. We look forward to the challenge of making our many practices fit into a limited schedule.

SUMMER TRAINING FEES

Training for **U12/U16 level 3 (Flare/Wildfire)** and **U19 Level 3/4 (Heat/Code Red)** will include weekly leveled tumbling times, and a **required** four-day camp on July 20-23 from 9am-12pm and July 20-23 from 1-4pm respectively. The four-day camp will be available upon tryout invite by June 23 (\$190.00). *tumbling classes are \$116.00. All Level 3+ teams (Wildfire and Code Red) will train the week after team placements (Aug 29-Sept 1 evenings, times TBD).

Training for **IO5 (Fever) U18 Level 4/5NT (Name TBD)** will include weekly leveled tumbling times and weekly training times on Tuesdays from 7-9:30pm (June 28, July 5, 12, 19, 26, Aug 2, 9, 16). The weekly training will be available upon tryout invite by June 23 (\$210.00). *tumbling classes are \$116.00

FAMILY DISCOUNTS

Families only pay one administration fee. If you have more than one immediate family member registered for the 2022/23 season you only pay one admin fee. For our 2021/22 team athletes: if you refer a friend and they register for a team for our 2022/23 season you receive a credit of \$100 in December.
