INTRODUCTION

2024 will begin our 19th season of excellence! We are excited for another year of competitive All-Star cheerleading; a season of training, routines, competition, and travel. Cheerleading provides individual athletes opportunities for personal success combined with the benefits that come with being part of a team. Commitment, trust, and connection are an important part of cheerleading topped off with the excitement of performing. With over 300 athletes and 25 certified coaches, we have a place for everyone!

At PFC, we operate a responsible business, we create a place for everyone to be successful, and we strive to create a family for athletes and parents alike. In the gym we guide our coaches and athletes with these club words: Family, Positivity, Leadership, Perseverance, Confidence, and Excellence. We look forward to sharing our family with yours.

OUR TEAMS

Our teams are split by age, by level, by experience, and amount of practice commitment. Age divisions are determined by the International All Star Federation (IASF) and Cheer Canada (CC). Ages in our sport are calculated based on birth year. An athlete is age eligible if they are the given age for that category at any time between **January 1, 2025 and December 31, 2025**.

Note: We roster our teams using the IASF/CC division list but we build teams based on ages that are best for teams and athletes. Please follow the guidelines below for the appropriate team options for your athlete!

TEAM PLACEMENTS

Athletes will have the opportunity to meet the staff, have some fun, learn and show off their skills working with coaches on stunting, jumping and tumbling. The team placement process enables us to build teams with like-minded athletes. This allows everyone to have success with the skills and abilities they bring to their team. After team placements are completed you will receive email with your team information including registration directions. You will have the team information by **Monday August 26th, 2024**, at this time we share final team lists. Everyone is placed on a team, so please make sure your contact info is correct and check your junk folder if you do not see anything from us. Register for team placements <u>here</u>. Please remember that every year your position will depend upon the makeup of the team, who is on it & what they have experience doing, so even if you were one position last year, it could change this year.

IMPORTANT DATES

All scheduling, important dates, and gym closures until winter break will be confirmed August 1, 2024. Anything from January on will be confirmed by November 1, 2024. Currently, you can take note of these important dates.

Step 1: Read over the information and decide on either pre-competitive or competitive programming. Families choose what suits them best, there is no experience required for any stream!

STREAMS

Pre-Competitive: Our pre-competitive stream is for athletes aged 3-12 and for families wanting to try out our sport, have additional commitments to other activities, or are wanting to keep expenses down. The pre-competitive teams run once per week on weekends in a non-competitive environment. They offer athletes the opportunity to perform at showcases while learning about our sport. Athletes learn all aspects of cheerleading and will learn up to a full routine. There is no competition or travel expense for this stream.

Competitive: Our competitive stream is intended for new and/or returning athletes born in 2019 or earlier who are interested in committing to two or three practices per week in a more competitive environment. These teams require a higher level of commitment and have competitions and travel opportunities within Saskatchewan and Alberta. Register for placements <u>HERE</u>.

Competitive L3+ Teams: We have tryouts on June 21, 2024 for Wildfire, Heat, Code Red, TNT, and Fever so that they can train over the summer preparing for the fall season. These teams are available for athletes who are born in 2012 or earlier and require a higher level of commitment and have competitions and travel opportunities in Saskatchewan, throughout Canada and sometimes internationally. Competitive: Team placements take place August 19-21, 2024. Step 3: If you have decided on:

Pre-competitive: you will receive an email confirming your registration & your invoice. Please check your account calendar for practice dates. You will receive an email from us in the last week of August with details about our open house and the first week of practices.

Competitive: you will receive an email confirming your team placement registration. Please read further for information about team placements. Upon completion of team placements you will receive an emailed link to register for the full season programming.

Competitive L3+: you will receive an email confirming your tryout registration. Upon completion of tryouts you will receive information regarding summer training. You do not need to attend team placements in August.

IMPORTANT: all of our communication will be sent through our online platform at www.prairiefirecheerleading.ca. Please ensure your contact information is up to date, and if you ever change your email address or want more than one email address to get news, updates, and important information from us ensure that you update your account using the account details tab. If you opt out of our emails you may miss important information about competitions, classes, and registration.

UNIFORMS

This season is the final year of our uniform cycle. Uniform pieces are sold separately or as a whole but are reused to mitigate the cost. We have a pre-loved sale at the end of August/beginning of September, and suggest watching the Prairie Fire Cheerleading Facebook group for members selling their used pieces. Competitive members also receive a club top.

Pre-competitive athletes will receive a club top. Athletes will wear black bottoms for showcases.

Competitive teams will wear the uniform bodysuit, skort & sleeves, with an optional sports bra.

Competitive level 3+ teams uniforms include the uniform bodysuit, skirt, sleeves, neck piece, and sports bra.
